Last update: 3.6.2020

Be sure to follow the new rules:

- ✓ Testing**
If you experience symptoms, get tested immediately and stay at home.
- ✓ Tracing**
Always leave your contact details whenever possible so you can be traced.
- ✓ Isolation/Quarantine**
Isolate yourself if you test positive. Quarantine yourself if you've had contact with someone who has tested positive.

Still important:

- ✓ Keep your distance.
- ✓ Recommendation: if it's not possible to keep your distance, wear a mask.
- ✓ Wash your hands thoroughly.
- ✓ Avoid shaking hands.
- ✓ Cough and sneeze into a tissue or the crook of your arm.
- ✓ Always call ahead before going to the doctor's or the emergency department.
- ✓ Continue to work from home if possible.

We will adhere to Canton Vaud Office of Early Childhood Development Health Protocol.

Customer Protocol

- Entry to the centre will be limited to families of 1 adult and 1 child or 2 siblings.
- Adults and children must disinfect their hands before entering the centre.
- Disinfectant Gel will be displayed at the front door.
- Masks are optional but it is still recommended if you cannot keep your distance.
- Adults and teachers have to keep their distance from each other.
- Older siblings should not come to the centre.
- Baby siblings should be carried on a baby carrier or car seat.
- Prams, scooters (trotinettes) or bicycles will not be allowed inside the building or the centre.
- Gymboree Play & Music will not be responsible for any lost items left outside the building.
- PlayGYM area will be open during specific hours, please check our summer schedule.
- Play time in between classes will not be possible as teacher will need to disinfect area and props.
- Kitchen area will not be open for breakfast, lunch or snack until further notice.
- Reception Desk will be closed for customer service.
- The reception/entrance hall should remain clear at all time:

- Gymboree Nyon main telephone line has been set not to leave messages.

Teachers & Class Protocol

- Teachers might decide to wear masks if they wish but this is not mandatory.
- Teachers will keep a safe distance from children although we know it is a very difficult task.
- We will continue to keep a limited number of children per class.
- Plan your snack time outside Gymboree centre.
- Help us to keep up our centre clean and organised at all times.

Entering the Centre:

- Adults and children must disinfect their hands before entering the centre.
- Disinfectant Gel will be displayed at the front door.

Reception Desk:

- The reception area should remain clear at all times.
- Any customer service questions will be answered via email with no exceptions.

Siblings:

- Older siblings should not come to the centre.
- Baby siblings should be carried on a baby carrier or car seat.
- Prams cannot be taken inside the centre or the building.

Class Preparation:

- Adults and children must prepare to enter the class:
 - Take socks and shoes off as usual.
 - Adults remain with socks at all times during their stay in the centre.
 - Adults and children to wash their hands before entering the class or Play Gym.
 - Change child's nappy if necessary.
 - Leave prams, bike, scooter outside the centre.

Sick Policy

- Gymboree Play & Music Nyon only accepts healthy adults and children.
- Anyone with mild symptoms of illness will not be allowed to enter the centre.
- We kindly ask you to be cautious, respectful and caring members of the Gymboree Family.
- Teachers may ask you to leave the class, if they consider that adult or child has symptoms.
- Symptoms are typically:
 - Fever of 38 or above.
 - Mild to non-stop cough
 - Sneezing
 - Physically not well.
 - Unwillingness to participate in activities with no reasons.
 - Red-eyes, body rushes or spots.

Anyone who has been in contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case should not come to the centre for a minimal period of 2 weeks. Such cases should be reported immediately to the Director of the Centre Claudia Stoppiello via email to claudia@steppingup.ch.
